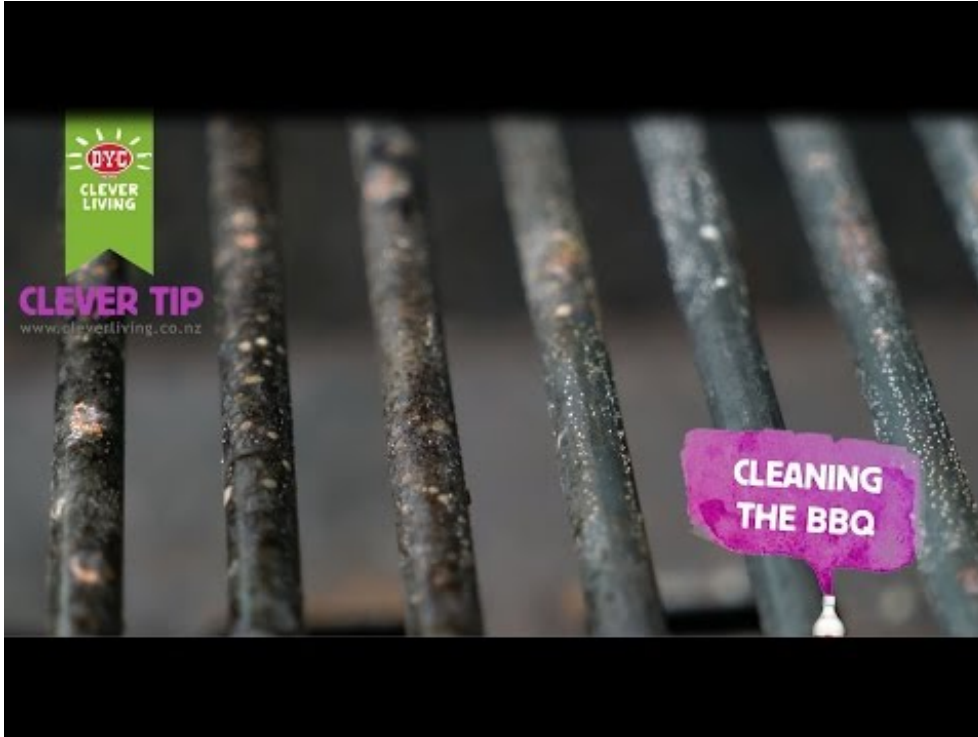


Cleaning your BBQ - DYC

Cleaning your BBQ

Cleaning your BBQ can be tricky especially on the open grill section. Vinegar is a natural cleaning solution that helps to remove rust, odours and germs.

For the outer part of your BBQ clean it with this homemade [multipurpose cleaner](#).

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Ingredients

DYC White Vinegar

Aluminium foil

Rice bran oil



Directions

1

Spray the cooking surface with vinegar. Allow to sit for 10 minutes. Note its OK to spray onto a warm, but not hot cooking surface (you dont want to burn yourself)

2

Scrunch up some aluminium foil and rub over the cooking surface to remove built up residue. You may want to wipe away any excess grime with a paper towel. Season cleaned cooking surfaces with rice bran oil.
